

LET SHABBAT FLOURISH: A Continuing Shabbat Experience

SHABBAT SEDER – **Friday, February 19, 2010 at 6:30 pm**

For Jews everywhere the Passover Seder is one of the highlights of the year, family, friends, tradition, good food and a strong taste of Jewish identity. Friday, February 19th we will experience Shabbat as a Seder (an ordered meal).

- A. Last year at our Shabbat Seders we prayed, ate, sang, and even danced together – let's do it again.
- B. The service – Shema, Amidah, Allyenu and Mourner's Kaddish will happen as part of the meal.
- C. Like a family Seder, it will be relaxed and focused at the same time.

D. NOTE: THERE WILL NOT BE AN EVENING SERVICE AT 7:30pm THAT NIGHT.

In order to allow as many people as possible to get the full experience of a Shabbat meal and a service together, this program will be subsidized using funds from the Rabbi's Fund given in memory of his parents. This will keep the cost reasonable for everyone:

\$12 – per Adult
\$ 5 - per Child ages 5 through 12
Free for Children under 5
\$30 per family will be the cap

I truly believe that these Shabbat Seders, which we will repeat several times this year, will bring together the best of Shabbat and the best of the Seder.

If you just want to join in the Seder without the meal – that is fine. Join us at 6:30 and stay through to the end.
