We believe we have responsibility

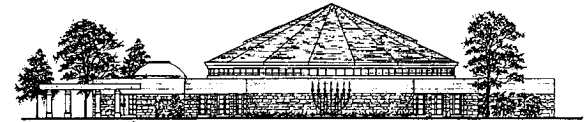
