2022 – 5783 High Holiday Ticket Policy

MEMBER TICKETS:

Tickets will only be issued to members in good standing. Prior year balances must be paid in full and 25% of the current years dues must be paid unless you have made special arrangements. Please call the Adath office if you have any questions or wish to make dues arrangements.

GUESTS, ASSOCIATE MEMBERS, AND ADULT CHILDREN (25 OR OLDER) OF MEMBERS:

You will be charged for the First Day of Rosh Hashanah, Kol Nidre, and Yom Kippur. There will be no charge for Erev Rosh Hashanah and the Second Day of Rosh Hashanah.

MEMBERS IN GOOD STANDING AT ANOTHER SYNAGOGUE:

Anyone requesting reciprocity must be a member in good standing of their synagogue and must provide a letter from their synagogue verifying their membership status.

Likewise, Adath will provide such letters for our members who will be visiting other synagogues for the High Holidays. If you need a letter, please give ample notice to the Adath office so that we may accommodate your request in a timely manner.

ZOOM:

We are requesting a donation of \$100 per adult in lieu of purchasing traditional guest tickets. This will allow your guests to attend all of our virtual services via Zoom.

FULL TIME STUDENTS:

Full time students will be admitted at no charge with proper I.D.. Arrangements for tickets should be made in advance by contacting the Jewish Life advisor at their school or the Synagogue office.

Associate Members:

\$60 /day per Adult (\$180 maximum)

Adult Children (25 or older) or Guests of Members:

\$50/day per Adult (\$150 maximum)

Non-Members:

\$125/day per Adult (\$375 maximum)

Zoom Guest:

\$100/per Adult (\$100 maximum)
